# Development of our vines

The vines are currently in a well developed vegetative cycle. Flowering progressed normally throughout June and we are starting to see the transformation of the inflorescences into grapes. At this time, the vines require a lot of attention, in particular trimming and successive dressing. No serious disease problems have been noted and the health of the vine is satisfactory. Taking into consideration the advanced flowering date, we can anticipate an early harvest of good quality.
